1	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Study Program of the Tohono O'odham Nation has been conducting
2		acomprehensivewaterstudyoftheNation'swaterresourcessince1998underPublicLaw
3		${\bf 93\text{-}638GrantAgreementwiththeBureauofReclamationoftheUnitedStatesDepartment}$
4		of the Interior, with a grant amount of \$5,485,171, pursuant to Section 303(b)(1) of the
5		Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982 (SAWRSA); and
6	WHEREAS,	twomoreyears, of thethreeadditionalyearsrequestedin2004, areneededtocompletethe
7		comprehensive water study, but the Bureau of Reclamation funding has been fully
8		expended part way through fiscal year 2005; and
9	WHEREAS,	in 2004 the Water Resources Study Program requested and was granted approval for the
10		Tohono O'odham Nation appropriation of \$3,753,966.11 from the interest in the SAWRSA
11		Trust Fund to make up for the shortfall in federal funds, to be expended by the Water
12		Resources Study Program over three (3) fiscal years and thereby enabling the completion
13		of the Tohono O'odham Nation's comprehensive water study; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Study Program projected budgets of:
15		1) \$1,242,848 for FY-2005
16		2) \$1,478,382.00 for FY-2006
17		3) \$1,032,735.00 for FY-2007, for a total of \$3,753,966
18	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Study Program requests that the balance of any unexpended funds
19		from any given fiscal year be retained and carried forward in the Water Resources Study $$
20		Program account for later use; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Water Resources Committee and the Budget and
22		Finance Committee have reviewed this proposal and recommend approval by the Tohono
23		O'odham Nation Legislative Council.
24	NOW, THEF	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby
25		continues to appropriate the unexpended balance of the original $\$3,753,966$ from the
26		interest in the SAWRSA Trust Fund for the use of the Water Resources Study Program for
27		the continuation and completion of the Nation's comprehensive water study over the
28		$approximately two (2)yearremainingperiodoftimeinwhichtheamountof\$1,\!478,\!382.00$
29		of funds shall be expended in accordance with budgets approved annually by the Tohono
30		O'odham Nation Legislative Council.
