

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Reauthorization of Executive Branch to Implement Capital Project Funding for the
Cultural Center Museum in Accordance with the Provisions of Generally Accepted
Accounting Principles)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-557

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has authorized the Cultural Center Museum as
2 a Capital Project in the fiscal year 2000 and committed revenues for the Cultural Center
3 Museum Project in the amount of \$15,191,080.00 by Resolution No. 2000-275; and

4 WHEREAS, these revenues extend beyond fiscal year 2005; and

5 WHEREAS, the authority of the Executive Branch to implement the activities beyond the current fiscal
6 year requires re-authorization by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council under
7 Resolution No. 2000-446; and

8 WHEREAS, the Cultural Center Museum Project's expenditures to date, projected expenditures and
9 projections for future fiscal years are provided for review:

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
17 re-authorizes \$11,537,259.84 for the Cultural Center Museum Project for Fiscal Year 2006.

18 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
19 Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are
20 authorized to negotiate and execute the budget, provided however, that any amendments
21 affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for further prior
22 approval.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH Day
24 of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,339.0 FOR; 590.0
25 AGAINST; 146.9 NOT VOTING; and 364.9[11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
26 by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted
27 by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
