

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Creation of a Dedicated Revenue Account for the Deposit of Funds
Received by the Tohono O'odham Nation's Solid Waste Management Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-558

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 97-041, the Legislative Council adopted the**
2 **Solid Waste Management Code and Solid Waste Management Plan and authorized the Solid**
3 **Waste Management Program to implement a system of collections, recycling, and disposal**
4 **of solid waste, and certain hazardous waste; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program in consideration of its service to provide solid waste**
6 **collection service to residents and businesses on the Nation, to pay for off reservation**
7 **disposal costs, to purchase new equipment, to hire essential personnel, and to respond to**
8 **the Nation's disposal needs and supplementing the Program's base budget with revenues**
9 **generated by the Program.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 11 1. **Rescinds Resolution No. 98-236 entitled Approving the Creation of a Dedicated Revenue**
12 **Account for the Deposit of Solid Waste Disposal Fees and Recycling Revenue and the**
13 **Modification of the Program's Budget.**
- 14 2. **Establishes a dedicated revenue account for the Solid Waste Management Program in**
15 **which all revenue funds generated by the Program shall be deposited to supplement**
16 **the Tribal Base budget.**
- 17 3. **That the Solid Waste Management Program provided a quarterly report to the Budget**
18 **& Finance Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and an annual report**
19 **be made to the Legislative Council regarding the expenditures from the revenue**
20 **account.**
- 21 4. **Upon availability of the revenues for expenditure, the Treasurer or other authorized**
22 **official of the Tohono O'odham Nation is hereby authorized to open a revenue account**
23 **and expend up to \$455,068.76 from such account in FY 2006.**
- 24 5. **The Solid Waste Management Program is authorized to expend funds in this dedicated**
25 **revenue account for personnel, operational, and major capital purchases consistent**
26 **with approved budgets.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH Day**
28 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,268.6 FOR; 949.5**
29 **AGAINST; 222.7 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
31 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
