

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Department of Health and Human Services Consolidated Healthy O'odham**  
**Promotion Program FY 2006 Budget (October 1, 2005 - September 30, 2006))**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-569

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation receives a Special Diabetes Programs for Indians grant  
2 through FY 2009 with a base budget of \$1,929,827.00; and

3 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-149, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the  
4 establishment of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program, funded by the  
5 Special Diabetes Programs for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of 1997; and

6 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 98-150, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the  
7 establishment of the Data Improvement Program under the Special Diabetes Programs  
8 for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of 1997; and

9 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-182, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the name  
10 change of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program to the Healthy O'odham  
11 Promotion Program; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services is requesting the Fiscal  
13 Year 2006 base budget of \$1,929,827.00.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
15 approves the Division of Healthy O'odham Promotion Program Fiscal Year 2006 budget for  
16 \$1,929,827.00.

17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
18 Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are  
19 authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments  
20 affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior  
21 approval.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup> Day  
23 of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-  
24 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
25 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
26 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
27 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
28 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
