

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of the Continuation of the CDC Effective Strategies to Prevent Motor  
Vehicle Injuries Among American Indians and Alaska Natives Grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-570**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Human Services has successfully**  
2 **administered the first year of a four-year CDC-funded grant "Effective Strategies to**  
3 **Prevent Motor Vehicle Injuries Among American Indians and Alaska Natives"; and**

4 **WHEREAS, this project is a collaboration between the Tohono O'odham Department of Human**  
5 **Services, the Tohono O'odham Police Department and the Indian Health Services; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the CDC has approved continuation funding for the second year of the grant for a total**  
7 **of \$71,480 for the period of September 1, 2005 - August 31, 2006.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
9 **approves the grant continuation in the amount of \$71,480.**

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
11 **Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official**  
12 **are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**  
13 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**  
14 **further prior approval.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
16 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
18 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
19 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
20 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
21 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




