5	funds from the United States Department of Agriculture for programs designed to
6	benefit women, infants and children; and
7	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with
8	Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and Children
9	(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2006
10	which was approved through Resolution No. 02-439; and
11	WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue to
12	be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health o
13	individuals at risk; and
14	WHEREAS, WIC has submitted the FY06 WIC budget and proposal in the amount of \$138,060.00
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and
16	authorizes expenditures of the FY06 attached budget in the amount of \$138,060.00
17	from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide service
18	to eligible women, infants and children.
19	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Tohono O'odhan
20	Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice Chairman and any designated Officia
21	is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Memorandum of Agreemen
22	associated with this program, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
23	funding or funding level of the Memorandum of Agreement shall be submitted fo
24	further approval.
