

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the FY 06 U.S. DOJ STOP Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary Grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-580**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services has been**  
2 **administering a STOP Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary Grant to plan**  
3 **coordinated domestic violence services; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, the Tohono O'odham Police**  
5 **Department, the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch, the Tohono O'odham Victim**  
6 **Witness Program of the Prosecutor's Office, and the Brewster Center for Domestic**  
7 **Violence Services, Inc. have been collaborating to plan coordinated domestic**  
8 **violence services; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Nation has received a new STOP Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary**  
10 **Grant to provide crisis intervention services to victims of domestic violence for a two-**  
11 **year period from October 1, 2005 – September 30, 2007.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:**

- 13 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the new grant award**  
14 **in the amount of \$200,000.**
- 15 **2. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the 12-month budget totaling**  
16 **\$200,000 that is attached.**
- 17 **3. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Nation to incur**  
18 **expenditures upon approval of this resolution from October 1, 2005 through**  
19 **September 30, 2007.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
21 **Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official**  
22 **are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**  
23 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**  
24 **further prior approval.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26<sup>th</sup> Day**  
26 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
31 **Stat. 984).**


