8	funds for operational costs to pay for purchase of replacement vehicles, pay for additional the initial costs the initial costs additional additional
9	staff to supplement permanent staff under the base budget, pay for training, pay for
10	vehicle maintenance and major vehicle repair costs, and supplements gas, oil and coolant
11	expenses; and
12	WHEREAS, a Third Party Revenue budget in the amount of \$974,205.14 for FY 2006 has been submitted
13	for review and approval by the Department of Health and Human Services for the Division
14	of Health Transportation Service.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:
16	$1. \ Approves the attached FY2006 Third Party Revenue Budget in the amount of\$974,205.14$
17	to supplement the FY 2006 Health Transportation Service budget.
