

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Pisin Mo'o District Continuing Resolution)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-600

1 **WHEREAS, in August 2005 the Annual Gaming distribution for 2006 went out to all the Nation's**
2 **eleven districts; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Pisin Mo'o District received their share of revenues and have gone to the**
4 **communities to do presentations of a proposed draft budget; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the four communities were each given twenty thousand (\$20,000) to budget for their**
6 **community's needs; and**

7 **WHEREAS, at this time the District's FY 2006 budget and the communities' budgets are still in**
8 **review.**


9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pisin Mo'o District Council is respectfully requesting**
10 **from the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council to approve the Continuing Resolution**
11 **to expend funds to continue all operations, projects and services beyond September**
12 **30, 2005.**

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there are sufficient funds within the Pisin Mo'o District FY 2005**
14 **budget to cover expenditures beyond September 30, 2005.**

15 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Continuing Resolution be in effect until the Pisin Mo'o District**
16 **presents their FY 2006 Budget to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for**
17 **approval.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27th Day**
20 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,282.05 FOR;**
21 **155.40 AGAINST; 1,003.35 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
22 **Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
23 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
24 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act**
25 **of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






