RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving the Grant of Permanent Rights-of-Way, and Approving the Land Appraisals Conducted by R. Sanchez Appraisals for the Construction of the Off-Farm Lease Flood Control Channel Improvements and Extension of the CAP Link Pipeline associated with the San Xavier Farm Rehabilitation Project on Tribal Trust Lands)

DEFEATED RESOLUTION NO. 05-604

1	WHEREAS,	the San Xavier District of the Tohono O'odham Nation has contracted a function of
2		the United States, through Bureau of Reclamation pursuant to Title I of the Indian
3		Self-Determination Act, P.L. 93-638; and
4	WHEREAS,	under the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act (SAWRSA) of 1982, Federal
5		funds have been allocated to rehabilitate and extend the San Xavier Cooperative
6		Farm; and
7	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 2000-349, has
8		authorized the San Xavier District to implement the farm rehabilitation; and
9	WHEREAS,	the San Xavier District continues to work with the Bureau of Reclamation, Pima
10		County, Bureau of Indian Affairs and the San Xavier Cooperative Farm for flood
11		protection associated with the rehabilitation of the Farm; and
12	WHEREAS,	the San Xavier District is requesting the necessary permanent easement/rights-of-
13		way to be granted to the United States Bureau of Reclamation to facilitate
14		construction of flood control improvements on Tribal Trust Land, Tract SXF-T3 not
15		under the San Xavier Cooperative Farm Lease, and to extend the CAP Link Pipeline
16		Tract SXF-T2 which is on the Farm Lease, for a water conduit and related facilities
17		consisting of buried pipelines and other fixtures, devices, and appurtenances; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has point five percent (0.5%) interest in Allotment 160,
19		site to be excavated for the construction of a 440-foot approach channel south of San
20		Xavier Road and east of Little Nogales Road on the West Branch of the Santa Cruz
21		River; and
22	WHEREAS,	land appraisals have been performed by R. Sanchez Appraisals, a State-Certified
23		Appraiser, and appraisal reports (attached here to) were completed according to the
24		"Uniformed Appraisal Standards for Federal Land Acquisition"; and
25	WHEREAS,	the valuesoftheTribalTrustLandparcelstobeutilizedforpermanentrights-of-way
26		were determined at \$20,692.00 for Tract SXF-T2, \$35,828.00 for Tract SXF-T3 and
27		\$1,021.39 for Allotment 160 respectively; and

Sanchez Appraisals for the Construction of the Off-Farm Lease Flood Control Channel Improvements and Extension of the CAP Link Pipeline associated with the San Xavier Farm Rehabilitation Project on Tribal Trust Lands) Page 2 of 3 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and Office of Special Trustee have reviewed the 1 2 appraisal reports to the three aforementioned parcels and find the appraisal amount 3 to be fair and just; and 4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Natural Resources, Water Resources and 5 Agricultural Committees have reviewed the appraisals and the purpose and basis for determining the value of the land and have recommended acceptance of the offer in 6 7 the amounts of \$20,692.00 for Tract SXF-T2, \$35,828.00 for Tract SXF-T3 and \$1,021.398 for Allotment 160: and 9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes that permanent easements of rights-of-way 10 are a necessary part of completing the San Xavier Farm Rehabilitation Project. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby 11 approve the grant of permanent rights-of-way to the Bureau of Reclamation, in the 12 13 name of the United States, for two parcels of tribal trust lands located on the San 14 Xavier District and for Allotment 160 in which the Nation owns a point five percent 15 (0.5%) interest, to be utilized for the purpose of construction for off-farm flood protection and extension of the CAP Link Pipeline associated with the rehabilitation 16 17 of the San Xavier Cooperative Farm. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation has authorized appraisal payment 19 for rights-of-way on tribal property to be returned to respective Districts, pursuant 20 to Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution Nos. 99-388, 35-89, 04-156, and 21 09-89. 22 BEIT FINALLY RESOLVED that the amount due to the Nation for the required permanent rights-of-23 way in the total amount of \$57,541.39, for the Tribal Trust Lands and the Nation's interest in Allotment 160, is hereby waived by the Nation and will be paid directly to 24 25 San Xavier District by the Bureau of Reclamation. The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the $28^{ ext{TH}}$ 26 Day of <u>SEPTEMBER, 2005</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present, and by a vote of <u>349.2</u> FOR; 27 28 1,919.8 AGAINST; 171.8 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a 29 majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono 30 O'odham Nation.
