

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Issuing Certificate of Election from the May 28, 2005 General Election for Baboquivari
District Alternate Lucilda J. Valenzuela (Norris) to the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council and Seating Such Elected Official)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-606

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation conducted a general election on Saturday, May 28, 2005**
2 **for the offices of representatives and alternates to the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
3 **Council; and**

4 **WHEREAS, on May 29, 2005 the Election Board issued and posted its Certification of Election**
5 **Results, incorporated herein by this reference, pursuant to Section 6(K) of Article VII**
6 **of the Uniform Election Ordinance; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Section 6(N) of Article VII of the Uniform Election Ordinance requires that the**
8 **Legislative Council issue Certificates of Election to, and seat, the candidates who**
9 **receive the highest number of votes for each Council seat, provided however, that any**
10 **person elected to public office who holds another elective public office of the Nation**
11 **must resign before being seated; and**

12 **WHEREAS, while the Council did seat the majority of Legislative Council alternates elected in**
13 **the 2005 general election pursuant to Resolution No. 05-253, it was necessary for**
14 **Lucilda J. Valenzuela (Norris) to resign another elective office prior to being seated.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Tohono O'odham**
16 **Legislative Council are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Council to**
17 **execute and deliver a Certificate of Election seating Lucilda J. Valenzuela (Norris) as**
18 **the Baboquivari District Alternate to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, who**
19 **shall hold her office for a term of four (4) years from June 6, 2005 or until her**
20 **successor has been elected, certified and seated.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH Day**
22 **of OCTOBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
24 **Section 1 (g) of Article VI and Section 7 of Article X of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**
25 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
26 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16**
27 **of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






