3		"Attorneys"), in the amount of \$10,000 for the period ending September 30, 2005, to
4		(1) negotiate a Trust Agreement with Wells Fargo Bank (the "Trustee") which protects
5		the interests of minors and legally incompetent persons regarding per capita
6		distributions authorized by the revenue allocation plans adopted by the Tohono
7	Section	O'odham Nation under the terms of the Initiative (No. IN-01-97), (2) provide legal
8		representation concerning tax compliance arising under the Trust Agreement, (3)
9		negotiate a provision in the Trust Agreement which requires the Trustee to reimburse
10		the Attorneys for all costs and fees expended under the Attorney Contract, and (4)
11		address other legal matters as may be assigned by the Attorney General to the
12		Attorneys within the scope of the Attorney Contract; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2005; and
14	WHEREAS,	continued  representation  is  necessary  to  protect  the  minors  and  legally  in competent
15		persons regarding their interests in the per capita distributions; and
16	WHEREAS,	theAttorneyGeneralhasproposedanAttorneyContractwiththeAttorneysforFiscal
17		Year 2006 in the amount of \$10,000, a copy of which is attached hereto; and
18	WHEREAS,	there  are  sufficient  funds  available  in  the  Initiative  Legal  Research  Account  (Account  and  account  account
19		No. 24-1809-810) to fund the Attorney Contract; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Investment Committees recommend the approval of the
21		Attorney Contract by the Legislative Council.
22	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
23		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract
24		with the law firm of Yoder & Langford, P.C. for the period from October 1, 2005 to
25		September 30, 2006 in the amount of \$10,000 and in substantially the form
26		attached hereto.
27		2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided from the Initiative Legal
28		Research Account (Account No. 24-1809-810).
