

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting October 20, 2005 Special Session to Address FY 2005 12% Distribution Agreements)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 05-619

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult, negotiate and conclude**
2 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal,**
3 **State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies,**
4 **or political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters**
5 **within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council"; and**

6 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 02-562, the Legislative Council approved a new tribal-**
7 **state gaming compact (the "Compact") with the State of Arizona; and**

8 **WHEREAS, Section 12 of the Compact requires that the Nation make certain annual**
9 **contributions in consideration for guarantees of substantial exclusivity; and**


10 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12(d) of the Compact, the Nation agreed to contribute twelve**
11 **percent of its annual tribal contribution (the "12% Distribution") to cities, towns, and**
12 **counties for government services that benefit the general public; and**

13 **WHEREAS the Nation's FY 2005 12% Distribution is due on October 25, 2005 and it is necessary**
14 **to hold a special session before that date to approve the proposals for making the FY**
15 **2005 12% Distribution.**

16 **NOW ,THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby sets a**
17 **special session for October 20, 2005 to address FY 2005 12% Distribution proposals.**

18 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH. Day of**
19 **OCTOBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
21 **Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
22 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
23 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
24 **Stat. 984).**
