(Approval to accept the Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Services Grant No. MN-00-05-0034-05 for \$16,690 from the Institute of Museum and Library Services to the Tohono O'odham Nation's Cultural Center & Museum and authorization to expend funds)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-636

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of promoting the**
2 **understanding of O'odham himdag from historical and contemporary perspectives;**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 2000-275 on**
5 **June 09, 2000, approving appropriations for the design, construction, staffing and**
6 **operations of a cultural center and museum for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Center/Museum Project submitted a grant application to the Institute**
8 **of Museum and Library Services for the production of a cornerstone publication that**
9 **will be available when the Himdag Ki: Hekihu, Hemu, Im B I-Ha'ap opens; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the cornerstone publication will be a current, engaging book that describes the**
11 **history, culture and language of the Tohono O'odham, using the narratives of 16**
12 **members of the Nation speaking of Himdag c Ki: and sharing their thoughts about the**
13 **building of this home for culture; and**

14 **WHEREAS, a distinguished group of staff and advisors, including Stephanie Bradford, Reva**
15 **Mariah Gover, Joseph T. Joaquin, Eric J. Kaldahl, Ph.D., Daniel Lopez, Bernard G.**
16 **Siquieros, and Ofelia Zepeda, Ph.D., will guide the direction and content of the**
17 **cornerstone publication; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Center/Museum Project received notification of the grant award of**
19 **\$16,690 from the Institute of Museum and Library Services, dated September 20, 2005.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
21 **accepts the Cultural Center/Museum Project's Grant No. MN-00-05-0034-05 in the**
22 **amount of \$16,690 from the Institute of Museum and Library Services for a**
23 **cornerstone publication and to set up an account from which expenditures can be**
24 **made and to expend the funds according to the attached budget.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
26 **Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official**
27 **are authorized to negotiate and execute the budget, provided however, that any**
28 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted**
29 **for further prior approval.**
