

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving an Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of DeConcini McDonald Yetwin & Lacy, P.C)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-640

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 04-668, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation")  
2 entered into an Attorney Contract with the law firm of DeConcini McDonald Yetwin  
3 & Lacy (the "Attorneys") to provide legal representation to the Nation to the Project  
4 for fiscal year 2005; and

5 WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2005; and

6 WHEREAS, the design and construction of the *Himdag Ki: Hekihu, Hemu, Im B I-Ha'ap*, the  
7 Tohono O'odham Nation Cultural Center & Museum will continue through fiscal year  
8 2006; and

9 WHEREAS, the Cultural Center/Museum Project requires continuing legal representation  
10 related to negotiation of the construction contract and such other matters as may be  
11 assigned by the Attorney General with the concurrence of the Project Administrator;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the Cultural Center/Museum Project recommends the engagement of the Attorneys  
14 for the foregoing legal services; and

15 WHEREAS, attached hereto is an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys in the amount of \$7,500 for  
16 fiscal year 2006; and

17 WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation, Domestic Affairs, and Budget & Finance Committees  
18 recommend approval of the Attorney Contract.

19 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 20 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract  
21 with the law firm of DeConcini McDonald Yetwin & Lacy in the amount of \$7,500  
22 for fiscal year 2006 and in the form attached hereto.
- 23 2. Funding of the Attorney Contract shall be provided from the Cultural  
24 Center/Museum Project budget (Account No. 50-1516-810).
- 25 3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney  
26 Contract.

27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
28 of OCTOBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-  
29 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
30 Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
31 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
32 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
33 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


