

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of Rosin & Reiniger Relating to
Indian Child Welfare Act Proceedings in New York County Court)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-676

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 04-553, the Tohono O'odham Nation
2 entered into an Attorney Contract with the law firm of Rosin & Reiniger for the period
3 ending September 30, 2005; and

4 WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2005; and

5 WHEREAS, continued representation is required to adequately protect the interests of the
6 Nation in an adoption proceeding under the Indian Child Welfare Act which is
7 pending in New York County Court (Case No. A-5193/04); and

8 WHEREAS, the Attorney General recommends continuing the engagement of the law firm of
9 Rosin & Reiniger to provide such representation under an Attorney Contract in the
10 amount of \$30,000 for the period October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006; and

11 WHEREAS, the budget for the Office of Attorney General (01-1031-810) has sufficient funds for the
12 Contract amount; and


13 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees recommend approval of the
14 Attorney Contract by the Legislative Council.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 16 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the Attorney Contract with
17 the law firm of Rosin & Reiniger in the amount of \$30,000 for Fiscal Year 2006, for
18 the period October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006, in the form attached hereto.
- 19 2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided from the budget of the Office
20 of Attorney General (01-1031-810).
- 21 3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney
22 Contract.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH. Day
24 of NOVEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-
25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
26 Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
27 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






