

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2006 Budget Amendment No. 1 for Tohono O'odham Nation Police  
Department 638 BIA Contract to Add in Line Items 721 Other Supplies and 722  
Program Supplies for Match to TRGP Grants)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-695**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracts its own Law Enforcement, Corrections and**  
2 **Ranger Programs under the 638 BIA Master Contract; and**

3 **WHEREAS, TONPD has been successful in being awarded for additional funding with the U.S.**  
4 **Department of Justice-COPS TRGP grants for Fiscal Year 2006; and**

5 **WHEREAS, in order to accept the grant, a requirement of a 25% local share is necessary and has**  
6 **been identified under the 638 BIA Law Enforcement Budget for FY 2006; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the need to establish two line items for the following equipment under 721 Supplies-**  
8 **Other: to purchase portable radios, batteries, desk computers including accessories**  
9 **and 722 Program Supplies: to purchase bulletproof vests and 75 Glock 40 Caliber**  
10 **firearms including accessories, i.e. special light, holsters is necessary; and**

11 **WHEREAS, under the FY 2006 BIA 638 Law Enforcement Contract there are no line items for 721**  
12 **Supplies-Other and 722 Program Supplies; and**

13 **WHEREAS, in order to purchase such equipment and supplies, these two new line items must be**  
14 **created for Supplies-Other account no. 10-1090-721 and Program Supplies account**  
15 **10-1090-722.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**  
17 **hereby accepts, approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 1 for the**  
18 **establishment of the two new line items under account number 10-1090-721 Supplies-**  
19 **Other and account number 10-1090-722 Program Supplies to the FY 2006 Tohono**  
20 **O'odham Nation Police Department 638 BIA Budget.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the line items are to be solely used as the Local Share for the U.S.**  
22 **Department of Justice COPS-TRGP Grant for the acquisition of equipment and**  
23 **supplies as needed.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Vice Chairman is hereby authorized**  
25 **to negotiate and execute the budget provided and that any amendments affecting the**  
26 **funding or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for approval by the**  
27 **Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council.**




