BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Joseph M. Garcia is hereby recognized as the Lieutenant Governor of O'odham in Mexico.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all matters affecting O'odham in Mexico will be presented to the Traditional O'odham Leaders who have the responsibility for determining their issues and any and all matters will be presented to the Tohono O'odham Nation Government through the Governor and/or the Lieutenant Governor in his absence.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH. Day of DECEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,049.95 FOR; 956.2 AGAINST; 434.65 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article II and Section 1 (b)&(l) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
