5	WHEREAS, the Hospital Replacement Steering Committee consists of representatives from the						
6	Indian Health Service, the Nation's Health Department, the Nation's Executive Office						
7	and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Health & Human Services Committee

9	WHEREAS, the Hospital Replacement Steering Committee has been working diligently to obtain						
10	community input and hosted two Public Hearings on the Hospital Replacement						
11	(September 15, 2005 & October 18, 2005); and						
12	$WHE REAS,\ the Nation has been for the past sixteen years advocating for a replacement of the Sells$						
13	Hospital and is now on the priority list for replacement; and						
14	WHEREAS, the Hospital Replacement Committee has identified the replacement to be an						
15	Alternative Rural Hospital to meet the health service needs of the Tohono O'odham						
16	Nation.						
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby						
18	support the construction of an Alternative Rural Hospital to replace the Sells Hospital						
19	and directs the Indian Health Service to proceed with this option with the continued						
20	direct consultation with the Tohono O'odham Nation.
