RESOLUTION NO. 06-010

1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 02-562, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") approved a new
2		tribal-state gaming compact (the "Compact") with the State of Arizona; and
3	WHEREAS,	as part of Section 12 of the Compact, the Nation did agree to make certain tribal
4		$contributions\ in\ consider at ion\ for\ substantial\ exclusivity\ covenants\ by\ the\ State; and$
5	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Section 12(d) of the Compact the Nation agreed to contribute twelve
6		percent of the tribal contribution (the "12% Distribution") to cities, towns, and
7		counties, for government services that benefit the general public; and
8	WHEREAS,	Section 12 (d) establishes that the Nation may elect to transfer all or a portion of the
9		12% Distribution to the Arizona Commerce and Economic Development Commission
10		(CEDC) Local Communities Fund, and in the past the Council has elected to make such
11		a transfer; and
12	WHEREAS,	the CEDC did take and hold some of the Nation's 12% Distribution monies in an
13		interest bearing account and did ultimately distribute the monies in specified
14		amounts to the cities, towns, counties, and other organizations that the Nation had
15		designated as recipients; and
16	WHEREAS,	although the CEDC did distribute the 12% Distribution in a timely manner, some
17		interest did accrue on the monies held by the CEDC; and
18	WHEREAS,	the 12% Distribution monies held by the CEDC, including any interest accrued, may
19		${\bf not}\ {\bf be}\ {\bf distributed}\ {\bf by}\ {\bf the}\ {\bf CEDC}\ {\bf without}\ {\bf authorization}\ {\bf from}\ {\bf the}\ {\bf Nation}\ {\bf designating}\ {\bf a}$
20		recipient of the money and a specific amount to be distributed; and
21	WHEREAS,	on December 29, 2005, the Commerce Committee and the Chairwoman of the Nation
22		did meet and select the YWCA to receive the interest amount in the CEDC Local
23		Communities Fund as of the last date available prior to the next General Session of
24		Council; and
25	WHEREAS,	as of January 3, 2006 the balance of the Nation's interest held by the CEDC was
26		\$14,887.51 .

5	encourages girls 9 to 14 to pursue careers in technology.
6	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby authorize and
7	direct the Arizona CEDC to work with the YWCA to enter into an agreement whereby
8	the YWCA will receive \$14,887.51 of the 12% Distribution interest currently held by
9	the CEDC on behalf of the Nation.
