LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 06-018

1 **WHEREAS, according to the Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 1 D1., "The Legislative Council**
2 **may, by majority vote, call for a Special Session to be held for the purposes of**
3 **completing unfinished agenda, addressing issues requiring an Executive Session,**
4 **and/or reviewing special reports from Committees, Programs or other sources"; and**

6 **that a Special Session be set for Tuesday, January 24, 2006 for school presentation**

19 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
20 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
