

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting January 26, 2006 Special Session Regarding Per Capita Issues)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 06-019

1 **WHEREAS, according to the Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 1.D.1., "The Legislative Council**
2 **may, by majority vote, call for a Special Session to be held for the purposes of**
3 **completing unfinished agenda, addressing issues requiring an Executive Session,**
4 **and/or reviewing special reports from Committees, Programs or other sources"; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Investment Committee has requested that a special session be set for**
6 **January 26, 2006 to address two per capita issues: (1) minors' accounts and (2) draft**
7 **(third) per capita distribution plan.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby sets a**
9 **Special Session for January 26, 2006 to address two per capita issues: (1) minors'**
10 **accounts and (2) draft (third) per capita distribution plan.**

11 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. Day of**
12 **JANUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
13 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
14 **Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
15 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
16 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
17 **Stat. 984).**
