

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of the Employment & Training Program PY 05 Annual Program Budget  
Amendment/Modification #2 - Department of Labor - Comprehensive Service Plan)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-029**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor - Comprehensive Service Plan and Annual Budget**  
2 **Amendment/Modification #2 final allocation of \$413,804.00 beginning July 1, 2005**  
3 **and ending June 30, 2008; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor - Comprehensive Service Plan and budgets**  
5 **amendment/modification #2, have been changed to reflect the addition of two (2)**  
6 **program staff positions of an Intake Specialist and a Quality Assurance Supervisor**  
7 **and the re-classification of a program van driver position to the Follow Up**  
8 **Supervisor; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the budget amendment/modification #2 approves these positions and any retro**  
10 **salaries effective January 1, 2006.**


11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
12 **approve the Department of Labor Comprehensive Service Plan and Budget**  
13 **Modification/Amendment #2 PY 2005 in the amount of \$413,804.00 with the addition**  
14 **of two (2) additional staff positions and a re-classification of a program van driver to**  
15 **the Follow Up Supervisor.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the salary changes are retro active effective January 1, 2006 for the**  
17 **re-classified position.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
19 **Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairwoman is hereby authorized to negotiate and**  
20 **execute the contracts and plans, provided however, that any amendment affecting**  
21 **the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior**  
22 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>th</sup> Day**  
24 **of JANUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
26 **Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
29 **Stat. 984).**
