

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Participation of KOHN 91.9 FM in the Center for Native American
Public Radio's Interconnection Grant Proposal and Submission of a Grant
Application to Public Telecommunications Facilities Program)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-056

1 **WHEREAS, KOHN 91.9 FM is a non-commercial educational radio station licensed to the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Center for Native American Public Radio (CNAPR) provides technical, fundraising,**
4 **and programmatic support to nearly 30 public radio stations serving Native American**
5 **listeners; and**

6 **WHEREAS, CNAPR has initiated an Interconnection Project to assist Native owned radio stations**
7 **that are not currently connected to the Public Radio Satellite System (PRSS) to obtain**
8 **the necessary funding to purchase equipment to become an active participant in**
9 **PRSS and to interconnect the 33 Native owned radio stations; and**

10 **WHEREAS, CNAPR as a part of the Interconnection Project will hire a grant writer to prepare a**
11 **grant proposal on behalf of participating Native owned radio stations for submission**
12 **to the Public Telecommunications Facilities Program (PTFP) to fund the acquisition**
13 **of satellite equipment for interconnection; and**

14 **WHEREAS, participation in the Interconnection Project will require KOHN 91.9 FM to share the**
15 **cost of hiring a PTFP grant writer with CNAPR for a total cost of \$750 for KOHN with**
16 **the remaining balance to be contributed by CNAPR; provide PTFP grant matching**
17 **funds if KOHN receives a grant of an estimated \$5,850, 25% of the total expected**
18 **project cost of \$23,400, with the balance of \$17,550, 75% of the total expected project**
19 **cost, to covered by the grant and pay subscription fees to PRSS; and**

20 **WHEREAS, KOHN's operating annual operating budget is sufficient to meet the costs the**
21 **Interconnection Project listed above without needing additional funding for which**
22 **provisions are being proposed in KOHN's fiscal year 2007 budget, the expected grant**
23 **year of the project.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
25 **authorizes KOHN 91.9 FM to participate in the CNAPR Interconnection Project and to**
26 **submit a grant application to the Public Telecommunications Facilities Program.**



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1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that KOHN 91.9 FM is further authorized to designate a portion of its**
2 **operating annual budget to the cost sharing requirements of the Interconnection**
3 **Project, to meeting PFTP grant matching requirements as may be necessary but not**
4 **more than 25% (\$5,850.00) of the total expected grant amount of \$23,400 and to**
5 **subscribe to the PRSS.**

6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26th Day**
7 **of JANUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
8 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
9 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
10 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
11 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
12 **Stat. 984).**


