

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the US Department of Homeland Security, Office for Domestic Preparedness,
2005 State Homeland Security Grant #2005-GE-T5-0030 for \$166,980.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-066

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants within the**
2 **program period that was introduced on 10/01/04 to individual states, to fund**
3 **equipment purchases and training by departments that provide public safety**
4 **services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the respective state,**
6 **requiring tribes to sign a Letter of Offer and Acceptance; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated a Letter of Offer and Acceptance with the**
8 **State of Arizona for the purpose of obligating and distributing funds from the U.S.**
9 **Department of Homeland Security, Office of Domestic Preparedness, Homeland**
10 **Security Grant Program on a reimbursement basis to finance equipment purchases,**
11 **training costs and other needs for homeland security; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Letter of Offer and Acceptance was approved in the form attached hereto by the**
13 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution 05-489 and subsequently**
14 **signed by the Chairwoman; and**

15 **WHEREAS, on 12/05/05, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Arizona**
16 **Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$166,980.00 as part**
17 **of the 2005 grant program for the purchase of specific equipment needed for an**
18 **automated fingerprint system; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the 2005 grant award of \$166,980.00 has been reviewed by the Office of Grants &**
20 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**
21 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative**
22 **Council.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
24 **accepts the grant award of \$166,980.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono**
25 **O'odham Nation General Fund for the purchase of equipment needed for an**
26 **automated fingerprint system and further approves the indirect cost to administer**
27 **this grant as it stipulates within the grant program guidance.**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of Emergency Management is**
2 **authorized to expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$166,980.00 in**
3 **accordance with the terms of the grant award period of 10/01/04 to 03/31/2007, with**
4 **any extensions of time reasonably necessary which are approved by the granting**
5 **agency to be brought back to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval.**

6 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that, by this resolution, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
7 **authorizes the Vice-Chairman of the Nation to enter into any necessary agreements**
8 **therefore accepting the above-mentioned US Department of Homeland Security,**
9 **State Homeland Security Grants.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06th Day**
11 **of FEBRUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
12 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
13 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
14 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
15 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
16 **Stat. 984).**




