

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the US Department of Homeland Security, Office for Domestic Preparedness,
2005 State Homeland Security Grant # 2005-GE-T5-0030 for \$39,500.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-068

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants within the**
2 **program period that was introduced on 10/01/04 to individual states, to fund**
3 **equipment purchases and training by departments that provide public safety**
4 **services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the respective state,**
6 **requiring tribes to sign a Letter of Offer and Acceptance; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated a Letter of Offer and Acceptance with the**
8 **State of Arizona for the purpose of obligating and distributing funds from the U.S.**
9 **Department of Homeland Security, Office of Domestic Preparedness, Homeland**
10 **Security Grant Program on a reimbursement basis to finance equipment purchases,**
11 **training costs and other needs for homeland security; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Letter of Offer and Acceptance was approved in the form attached hereto by the**
13 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution 05-489 and subsequently**
14 **signed by the Chairwoman; and**

15 **WHEREAS, on 12/05/05, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Arizona**
16 **Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$39,500.00 as part of**
17 **the 2005 grant program for the purchase of specific equipment needed for enhancing**
18 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety Mobile Command Vehicle;**
19 **and**

20 **WHEREAS, the 2005 grant award of \$39,500.00 has been reviewed by the Office of Grants &**
21 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**
22 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative**
23 **Council.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
25 **accepts the grant award of \$39,500.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Nation General Fund for the purchase of equipment needed for enhancing**
27 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety Mobile Command Vehicle**
28 **and approves a waiver of indirect cost to administer this grant as it does not pertain**
29 **to professional services.**

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of Emergency Management is
2 authorized to expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$39,500.00 in accordance
3 with the terms of the grant award period of 10/01/04 to 03/31/07, with any extensions
4 of time reasonably necessary which are approved by the granting agency to be
5 brought back to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval.

6 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that by this resolution, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
7 authorizes the Vice-Chairman of the Nation to enter into any necessary agreements
8 therefore accepting the above-mentioned US Department of Homeland Security,
9 State Homeland Security Grants.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06th. Day
11 of FEBRUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-
12 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
13 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
14 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
15 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
16 Stat. 984).
