	WHEREAS,	this remedy is only enforceable upon approval by the Legislative Council of a limited				
8		waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Nation; and				
9	WHEREAS,	granting a limited waiver is in the best interests of the Nation; and				
10	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources, Agriculture, and Budget and Finance Committees have				
11		reviewed the Construction Contract WPO-125-05.				
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:					
13		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby grants a limited waiver of				
14		sovereign immunity for the dispute resolution remedies provided in the				
15		Construction Contract WPO-125-05 which extend to proven sums owed by the				
16		Nation to the Contractor.				
17		2. The limited waiver of sovereign immunity shall be effective upon the date the				
18		Nation and the Contractor execute the Construction Contract WPO-125-05.				
19		3. Any references in the draft Construction Contract WPO-125-05 preserving the				
20		sovereign immunity of the Nation are superceded by this resolution granting a				
21		limited waiver of sovereign immunity.
