

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Release of \$1,500,000.00 from Public Law 99-503 funds to San Lucy District
to be used as Collateral for a Bonding Program for Vi-ikam Doag Industries, Inc.,
Construction Division)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-082

1 **WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1-84, the then Papago Council established Vi-ikam Doag Industries,**
2 **Inc. ("VDI") as the economic arm of San Lucy District and was created, in part, to**
3 **develop business and employment opportunities for San Lucy District members and**
4 **generate revenues for the benefit of San Lucy District; and**

5 **WHEREAS, VDI has requested financial assistance from San Lucy District for use in replacement**
6 **and additional bonding for the VDI Construction Division; and**

7 **WHEREAS, VDI will be unable to bid any additional projects without additional bonding capacity;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, VDI has determined that the addition of \$1,500,000.00 of funds will permit VDI to**
10 **bond up to \$4,000,000.00 in projects which is consistent with the VDI Construction**
11 **Division Business Plan; and**

12 **WHEREAS, without the additional bonding capacity, VDI will be unable to maintain the projected**
13 **growth of the VDI Construction Division and will be unable to support the projected**
14 **opportunities for employment of O'odham members, including San Lucy District**
15 **members; and**

16 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. SL-045-05 the San Lucy District Council supported the use of Public**
17 **Law 99-503 funds to provide collateral for the Bonding Program of VDI Construction**
18 **Division of Vi-ikam Doag Industries, Inc. and requested the Legislative Council to**
19 **approve the release of \$1,500,000.00 from Public Law 99-503 funds and wire transfer**
20 **such funds to San Lucy District Account; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Investment Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the request of San**
22 **Lucy District to release \$1,500,000.00 from Public Law 99-503 funds to fund a Bonding**
23 **Program for VDI and has determined that it is in the best interest of the Nation and**
24 **District to support the Bonding Program for VDI.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
26 **the release of \$1,500,000.00 from Public Law 99-503 funds to be wire transferred to**
27 **San Lucy District to be used as collateral for a Bonding Program for Vi-ikam Doag**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH of FEBRUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,231.6 FOR; 1,039.2 AGAINST; 170.0 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
