


**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Correcting 2005-2006 Legislative Calendar and Adopting 2006-2007 Legislative Calendar)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 06-088

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "establish rules**
2 **and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council" pursuant**
3 **to Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
4 **WHEREAS, on February 10, 2005, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted the 2005-2006**
5 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Calendar (June 01, 2005 - May 31, 2006 ("2005-**
6 **2006 Legislative Calendar") by Legislative Order No. 05-078; and**
7 **WHEREAS, the approved 2005-2006 Legislative Calendar incorrectly sets the 2006 Good Friday**
8 **holiday as March 24, 2006 instead of April 14, 2006 and therefore requires revision;**
9 **and**
10 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has been charged with developing the 2006-2007 Tohono**
11 **O'odham Legislative Council Calendar (for the period from June 01, 2006 to May 31,**
12 **2007), which is attached.**
13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the 2005-2006**
14 **Legislative Calendar is amended to recognize the 2006 Good Friday holiday on April**
15 **14, 2006 instead of March 24, 2006.**
16 **BE IT FINALLY ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby adopts the**
17 **attached 2006-2007 Legislative Calendar.**

18 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH. Day of**
19 **FEBRUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,271.9 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; 169.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
21 **Sections 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
