

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 06 Budget Amendment No. 2 for the Youth Transportation Art Grant)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-094

1 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department's, Youth Art Project has received an additional grant fund**
2 **in the amount of \$175,000; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the project is funded by a Pima Association of Governments (PAG) grant to enhance**
4 **community pride by involving District youth in designing public transportation art;**
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, the awarded grant amount of \$175,000.00 is requested to amend the FY 06 budget to**
7 **increase the total budget amount of \$224,424.17; and**


8 **WHEREAS, the grant will be administered by the Planning Department staff.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**
10 **approves the grant award of \$175,000.00 and includes the amended budget of**
11 **\$49,424.17 for a total budget of \$224,424.17.**

12 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, the Chairwoman,**
13 **Vice Chairman and any designated official are authorized to negotiate and execute**
14 **the grants, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding**
15 **levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10th. Day**
17 **of FEBRUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,813.6 FOR; -0-**
18 **AGAINST; 627.2 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
19 **Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
20 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
21 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
22 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
