

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment 1 to increase the Water Resources Study Program-FY2006
SAWRSA budget 21-1525 in the amount of \$820,292.36)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-098

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY2006 Water Resources Study**
2 **Program SAWRSA budget 21-1525 with Resolution 05-555; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the funding for the SAWRSA budget 21-1525 comes from the SAWRSA Trust Fund and,**
4 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Accounting Budget Office has calculated a carry forward amount of**
5 **\$820,292.36 from FY2005; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program requests that the FY 2005 carry forward amount**
7 **of \$820,292.36 be added to the FY2006 SAWRSA budget to increase the FY2006 amount**
8 **to \$2,298,674.36; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program also requests the approval of two reclassified**
10 **positions and that the salaries for these positions be retro-active from October 1,**
11 **2005; and**

12 **WHEREAS, this budget amendment has been reviewed by the Legislative Water Resources**
13 **Committee and the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

15 **1. Authorizes the increase of the FY2006 Water Resources Study Program SAWRSA**
16 **budget in the amount of \$820,292.36 for a total of \$2,298,674.36, in accordance**
17 **with the budget attached hereto.**

18 **2. Approves the salaries of the two reclassified positions that will be retro-active**
19 **from October 1, 2005.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman, and any designated**
22 **official are authorized to negotiate and execute the budget, provided however, that**
23 **any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget be submitted for**
24 **further approval.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10th. Day**
26 **of FEBRUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**
