

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving Amendment No. 1 to Attorney Contract with Yoder & Langford, P.C.)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-112

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 05-673, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved an**
2 **Attorney Contract with the law firm of Yoder & Langford, P.C., to provide legal advice**
3 **and representation to the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") in connection with the**
4 **implementation by the Nation of the 401(k) pension program; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract is in the amount of \$7,500 for fiscal year 2006 ending September**
6 **30, 2006; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to amend the Attorney Contract to expand the scope of**
8 **representation to include legal advice and representation to the Nation regarding**
9 **joinder and participation in the Arizona Public Safety Personnel Retirement System**
10 **("PSPRS"); and**

11 **WHEREAS, it is estimated that additional funds in the amount of \$10,500 may be needed to**
12 **provide for the legal work related to the PSPRS; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Police Department has agreed to fund the necessary legal work from Yoder &**
14 **Langford, P.C., to accomplish the Nation's joinder and participation in the PSPRS and**
15 **related changes in the Tohono O'odham Nation 401K Plan ; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the trustees of the Nation's 401(k) plan have reviewed this matter and recommend**
17 **approval of Amendment No. 1; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed this**
19 **matter and recommend approval of Amendment No. 1.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
21 **Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract with Yoder & Langford, P.C., expanding the**
22 **scope of representation to include legal work on the Nation's joinder and**
23 **participation in the PSPRS and adding additional funding to the contract in the**
24 **amount of \$10,500, to be funded by the Police Department, for a total contract**
25 **amount of \$18,000, and authorizes the Nation's Vice-Chairman to execute the**
26 **amendment.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND, Day**
28 **of FEBRUARY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,651.3 FOR; 210.50**
29 **AGAINST; 579.0 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (d)&(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
31 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
