

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Judiciary Budget Modification/Amendment #2, which Proposes New
Positions, Reclassified Positions and a Transferred Position)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-131

1 **WHEREAS, on September 29, 2005, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appropriated**
2 **\$5,143,789.82 for FY 2006 operations of the Tohono O'odham Justice Center, under**
3 **Resolution No. 05-589; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Justice Center has reviewed and evaluated the current Judicial staff and have**
5 **determined that in order to provide improved services in the area of security, case**
6 **management and operational management, a reclassification of positions will be**
7 **necessary; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the newly adopted court security and court officers policies have been approved and**
9 **will require additional staff, we propose to include a new court officer position and**
10 **upgrade the current security and court officers salaries; and**

11 **WHEREAS, upon further review and in order to provide more comprehensive services in the area**
12 **of treatment coordination and rehabilitation counseling, we have combined these**
13 **positions into the newly proposed position titled Rehabilitative Support Coordinator;**
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, a summary of reclassified positions and new positions and including job descriptions**
16 **which are attached; and**

17 **WHEREAS, this modification/amendment #2 also includes the transfer of an Office Support**
18 **Worker position from the Judicial Service P.L. 93-638 budget to the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Judiciary budget, due to the final allocation for the FY 2006 Judicial Service budget**
20 **under contract No. CTH54T61076 which reduces this budget by \$12,048.00; and**

21 **WHEREAS, this budget modification /amendment #2 also includes two (2) reimbursements**
22 **totaling \$1,358.90 (see attachments); and**

23 **WHEREAS, this Budget Modification/Amendment #2 has been reviewed by the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Judiciary and Budget and Finance Committees.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does approve the Justice Center**
26 **Budget Modification/Amendment #2 which includes Proposed Salaries, New Positions**

2 **Judicial Service Contract to the Judiciary Budget. (See attachment)**


3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the increase of \$250.00 to line item 650 Registration and Tuition**

6 **Judiciary's budget from \$5,143,789.82 to \$5,145,148.72 for FY 2006 only.**

7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves this**
8 **Budget Modification/Amendment #2.**


9 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels shall be**

15 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
16 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
17 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
