

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Bureau of Indian Affairs Proposal to Construct Turn Lanes on
Route 15 at Route 34)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-143

1 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) is in the process of preparing construction**
2 **documents, under project PIR 15 (23), to overlay 13.0 miles of BIA Route 15 from**
3 **State Route 86 north to Bridge H606 south of Santa Rosa, in Fiscal Year 2007; and**
4 **WHEREAS, there is a Nursing Home located on BIA Route 34 that is accessed from BIA Route 15,**
5 **at milepost 9.0", by employees and visitors to the nursing home and residents of the**
6 **Community of San Serfin, which is located east of the nursing home; and**
7 **WHEREAS, the Community of San Serfin and the Nursing Home Staff are concerned about the**
8 **safety and protection of nursing home employees and visitors and community**
9 **members turning onto BIA Route 34 from BIA Route 15 at milepost 9.0"; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the construction of turn-lanes on BIA Route 15 would greatly improve the safety of**
11 **this intersection; and**
12 **WHEREAS, the San Serfin Community has requested that turn lanes be constructed on BIA**
13 **Route 15 at its intersection with BIA Route 34 (at mile post 9.0") as part of the PIR**
14 **(23) overlay project and asked for the District Councils support of this request; and**
15 **WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District has passed Resolution No. 0510-097 supporting the**
16 **construction of turn lanes on BIA Route 15 at its intersection with BIA Route 34 (at**
17 **miles post 9.0±) as part of the PIR 15 (23) overlay project and requests that the**
18 **Chairperson of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Legislative Council authorize**
19 **the use fo a portion of the Nation's share of IRR Construction funds to construct the**
20 **requested turn lanes; and**
21 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the Gu Achi District Council's**
22 **request and recommends approval and support by the Legislative Council.**
23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
24 **supports the construction of turn lanes on BIA Route 15 at its intersection with BIA**
25 **Route 34 (at mile post 9.0") as part of the PIR 15 (23) overlay project and authorizes**
26 **the use of a portion of the Nation's share of Indian Reservation Roads (IRR)**
27 **construction funds to construct the requested turn lanes.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH of MARCH, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (i)(I) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




