

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Continuation Award for the Family Violence Prevention and Services
Grant from the U.S. Department of Human Services Administration for
Children and Families -DHHS/ACF)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-149

1 **WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is a health priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
2 **WHEREAS, domestic violence is a source of injuries for the individuals and family members;**
3 **and**
4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Domestic Violence Coalition is working to raise awareness of**
5 **domestic violence and develop services for domestic violence victims and their**
6 **families; and**
7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services received**
8 **a Family Violence Prevention and Services grant in FY 2005 for a total of \$129,725**
9 **that is currently being expended; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Children and Families has awarded a continuation of this**
11 **grant award in the amount of \$144,482 through September 30, 2006; and**
12 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed and obtained committee approval of the attached**
13 **budget which is incorporated by this reference, to be effective May 5, 2005 through**
14 **September 30, 2006 and requests authorization to expend the funds.**
15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**
16 **1. accepts and approves the grant award in the amount of \$144,482, 2005-**
17 **G991538 DHHS/ACF Family Violence and Prevention Services Grant.**
18 **2. approves the Family Violence Prevention and Services budget.**
19 **3. authorizes the Department of Health and Human Services Community Health**
20 **Division to expend such funds effective May 5, 2005 through September 30, 2006**
21 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels**
22 **of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by Council.**
23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation's Chairwoman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are authorized**
25 **to execute the grant agreement and take any other action necessary and proper to**
26 **implement the terms of this resolution.**


