

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2006 Legislative Branch Supplement Budget/Amendment No. 2)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-156

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds within the exclusive**
2 **control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate these funds for the**
3 **benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "all expenditures of these funds**
4 **shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or**
5 **ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2));**
6 **and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval of its FY**
8 **2006 Supplemental Budget/Amendment No. 2; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch administration has proposed a supplemental budget proposal**
10 **to increase funding to line items 711, Communication Expense and 721, Other**
11 **Supplies; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the proposed Supplemental Budget is to purchase cellular phones with accessories,**
13 **monthly services, to purchase 25 Laptops Computers with software and two Notebook**
14 **Computers; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch computers are continually experiencing technical problems**
16 **and the proposal for the additional computer equipment would assist in addressing**
17 **the ongoing computer problems; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee and the Legislative Council have reviewed the FY**
19 **2006 Legislative Branch Supplemental Budget/Amendment No. 2.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
21 **approves and authorizes expenditure of the FY 2006 Legislative Branch Supplemental**
22 **Budget/Amendment No. 2 from the FY 2006 Surplus in the amount of \$91,128.31, as**
23 **per the attached Supplemental Budget/Amendment.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. of**
25 **MARCH, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,964.3 FOR; 221.6**
26 **AGAINST; 254.9 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




