8	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
9	·	the acceptance and expenditure of the US Bureau of Land Management grant, in the
10		amount of \$50,000, for the Solid Waste Management Program FY2007 Undocumented
11		Migrant Waste budget 11-1513, in accordance with the attached budget hereto.

13		O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice Chairman and any
14		designated person are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,

16		shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
