

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY2007 Water Resources Study Program Southern Arizona Water
Rights Settlement Act Trust Fund account 21-1525)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-170

1 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program was granted an appropriation of \$3,753,966.00**
2 **from the interest in the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act (SAWRSA) Trust**
3 **Fund, by Council Resolution No. 05-555, to complete the Nation's comprehensive**
4 **water inventory; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has from FY2005 through FY2007 to complete the**
6 **Nation's comprehensive water study; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a FY2007 SAWRSA budget in the**
8 **amount of \$1,032,735.00; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program requests that the balance of any unexpended**
10 **funds from any given fiscal year be retained and carried forward in the Water**
11 **Resources Study Program account for later use; and**

12 **WHEREAS, an in kind match of \$8,422.00 from the FY2007 SAWRSA budget 21-1525 will be used**
13 **for the Water Resources Study Program FY2007 EPA 106 budget 11-5017; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the FY2007 SAWRSA budget 21-1525 has been reviewed by the Legislative Water**
15 **Resources Committee and the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 17 **1. Approves the expenditure of \$1,032,735.00 for the FY2007 SAWRSA budget 21-**
18 **1525, in accordance with the budget attached hereto.**
- 19 **2. Approves an in kind match of \$8,422.00 from the FY2007 SAWRSA budget 21-**
20 **1525 for the Water Resources Study Program EPA 106 budget 11-5017.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
22 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman, and any designated**
23 **official are authorized to negotiate and administer the appropriation, provided**
24 **however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the**
25 **appropriation shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Legislative Council.**




