

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Employment & Training Program Continual Appropriation 2006 for
Program Funding year 2005)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-177

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor – Comprehensive Service Plan 2005 is in the second year of**
2 **a four year grant with continual appropriation funds of approximately \$296,647.85**
3 **effective 07/01/05 ending 06/30/08 (Approved through Legislative Council Resolution**
4 **#06-029); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor – Supplemental Youth Service Plan 2005 is in the second**
6 **year of a four year grant with continual funds of approximately \$78,832.77 effective**
7 **06/01/05 ending 06/30/08 (Approved through Legislative Council Resolution #06-030);**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security 2005/06 is in the second year of a two**
10 **year contract with continual funds of approximately \$194,616.65 effective 06/01/05**
11 **ending 06/30/08 (Approved through Legislative Council Resolution #06-032); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services-Native Employment Works 2005 is a**
13 **continual grant until all funds are expended, has funds of approximately \$137,931.23**
14 **effective 07/01/05 ending 06/30/06 (Approved through Legislative Council Resolution**
15 **#06-031); and**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
17 **approve the Employment & Training continual funding of the Department of Labor**
18 **– Comprehensive Service Plan 2005 in the approximate amount of \$296,647.85, the**
19 **Department of Labor – Supplemental Youth Service Plan 2005 in the approximate**
20 **amount of \$78,832.77, the Arizona Department of Economic Security 2005/06 in the**
21 **approximate amount of \$194,616.65, and the Department of Health and Human**
22 **Services – Native Employment Works in the approximate amount of \$137,931.23 for**
23 **the period of July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007 in the combined approximate amount of**
24 **\$708,028.50.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
26 **Nation's Official, to wit; the Chairwoman and Vice Chairman and any designated**
27 **Official are authorized to negotiate and execute the contracts and plans, provided**

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1 however, that any amendment affecting the funds or funding levels of this contract
2 shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
3 Council.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21st. of
5 MARCH, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
6 169.0 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1
7 (d)(2)(3) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
8 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




