

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 07 U.S. DOJ STOP Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-189

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health & Human Services has been**
2 **administering a STOP Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary Grant to plan**
3 **coordinated domestic violence services; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health & Human Services, Tohono O'odham**
5 **Police Department, Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch, Tohono O'odham Victim**
6 **Witness Program of the Prosecutor's Office, and the Brewster Center Inc. for**
7 **Domestic Violence Services have been collaborating to plan coordinated domestic**
8 **violence services; and**


9 **WHEREAS, the Nation has received a new STOP Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary**
10 **Grant to provide crisis intervention services to victims of domestic violence grant**
11 **period from October 1, 2006 – September 30, 2007.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
13 **and authorizes the expenditure of the new FY 07 STOP Violence Against Indian**
14 **Women Discretionary Grant of \$117,963.29 beginning October 01, 2006 through**
15 **September 30, 2007.**

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
17 **Nation officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice Chairman and any designated**
18 **official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,**
19 **that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be**
20 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST day**
22 **of MARCH, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,269.0 FOR; -0-**
23 **AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and 171.8 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
24 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
25 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
26 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act**
27 **of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
