RESOLUTION NO. 06-196

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health**
2 **provides substance abuse and mental health services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Division of Behavioral Health submitted an application for this project in August**
4 **2004; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Safe and Bright Futures, Domestic Violence for Children and Adolescent Planning**
6 **Grant is a planning and design process for a comprehensive system that will reduce**
7 **violence against children, adolescents and provide direct service for the children,**
8 **adolescents, and their families; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Award was received for Fiscal Year 2005 in the amount of \$75,000.00 for**
10 **the first year of a two-year grant; and a continuation application for Year Two for**
11 **FY2006 was approved; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Safe and Bright Future, Domestic Violence for Children and Adolescents Planning**
13 **Grant and budget in the amount of \$73,639.00 for a No-Cost Extension for a Third Year**
14 **following the two-year grant is hereby submitted for review and approval by the**
15 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
17 **and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the Department of Health and**
18 **Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health FY 2007 The Safe and Bright Future,**
19 **Domestic Violence for Children and Adolescent Planning Grant and attached budget**
20 **in the amount of \$73,639.00 for a No-Cost Extension for a Third Year.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
22 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official**
23 **are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
24 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**
25 **further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**




