

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving STEPS to a Healthier US Grant, STEPS to a Healthier Arizona Initiative**  
**(October 1, 2006 – September 30, 2007))**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-203**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has applied and been approved to receive \$436,941 in**  
2 **competitive funding from the Arizona Department of Health Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-149, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**  
4 **establishment of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program, funded by the**  
5 **Special Diabetes Programs for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of**  
6 **1997; and**

7 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-182, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**  
8 **name change of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program to the Healthy**  
9 **O'odham Promotion Program; and**


10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services is requesting the Fiscal Year**  
11 **2007 base budget of \$436,941.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**  
13 **and authorizes the expenditure of the FY 07 STEPS grant of \$436,941.00, beginning**  
14 **October 01, 2006 through September 30, 2007.**

15 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
16 **Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice Chairman and any designated**  
17 **Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,**  
18 **that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be**  
19 **submitted for further approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22<sup>ND</sup> day**  
21 **of MARCH, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
22 **AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
23 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**  
24 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


