5		to day project management for funded projects entering into site development, pre-
6		design, architecture and engineering design, including bidding and contracting with
7		a design team; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 04-652, adopt a Special
9		Projects Office FY 2005 Budget and through Resolution No. 03-427, has previously
10		authorized the Special Projects Office to operate during the FY 2004; and
11	WHEREAS,	funds are available in the Reserve Accounts for Early Childhood Head Start, Dialysis
12		Center and Westside Health Clinic, which may be used to consolidate the Special
13		Projects Office's Administration expense requirements for each project; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Special Projects Office's proposed consolidated FY 2007 Budget requires
15		\$274,833.37 to administer the Westside Health Clinic Project at 60% and Head Start
16		Facilities Project at 40%.
17	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
18		approve the use of funds specified from the following reserve account to fund the
19		Special Projects Office FY 2007 Budget: Head Start Administrative, 50-1263
20		(\$164,900.02); Westside Health Clinic Administration; 50-1464, (\$109,933.34); totaling
21		\$274,833.37.

23		authorizes the expenditures for the projects administered by the Special Projects
24		Office according to the FY 2006 budget in the amount of 274,833.37 effective October
25		1, 2006 thru September 30, 2007.
26	BE IT FINA	LLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
27		Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official
28		are authorized to negotiate and administer the budget, provided however, that any
