13	11-5017, in accordance with the budget attached hereto.
14	2. approves an in kind match of \$8,422.00 from the FY 2007 Water Resources Study
15	Program SAWRSA budget 21-1525 for the Water Resources Study Program EPA
16	budget 11-5017.
17	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
18	Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official
19	are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
20	amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for
21	further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
