17		Budget No.011095, and (2) authorizes the expenditure of funds appropriated to, and					
18		in accordance with, the Executive Branch FY 2007 Budget.					
19	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham						
20		Nation's Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are authorized to					
21		administer the Executive Branch FY 2007 Budget, provided, however, that any					
22		amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the Executive Branch FY 2007					
23		Budget shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
