

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Recognizing the Baboquivari District Council Appointment of Vernon Smith as  
Alternate to Legislative Representative Frances Miguel)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-217**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Election Board conducted the 2003 general election on**  
2 **Saturday, May 24, 2003; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Frances Miguel received the most votes for the open Baboquivari Legislative**  
4 **Representative seat during the 2003 general election; and**


5 **WHEREAS, a vacancy currently exists in the Legislative Council alternate seat for Councilwoman**  
6 **Miguel; and**

7 **WHEREAS, such vacancies are filled in the following manner: "If a vacancy should occur in the**  
8 **office of representative to the council, the alternate of that representative shall**  
9 **immediately succeed to the office of representative and the council of the district**  
10 **from which they were elected shall appoint an alternate who shall hold office for the**  
11 **unexpired term of his predecessor." (Uniform Election Ordinance, Article IV, Section**  
12 **5.B.); and**

13 **WHEREAS, on March 27, 2006 the Baboquivari District Council appointed Vernon Smith as**  
14 **alternate to Councilwoman Miguel pursuant to District Resolution No. 06-B-05.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes that**  
16 **(1) the Baboquivari District has duly appointed Vernon Smith as the Legislative**  
17 **Council alternate to Councilwoman Frances Miguel and (2) Vernon Smith is hereby**  
18 **seated as Councilwoman Miguel's alternate and shall serve when Councilwoman**  
19 **Frances Miguel is unable to attend a meeting in accordance with the Constitution and**  
20 **laws of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the rules and procedures of the Legislative**  
21 **Council.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 3<sup>RD</sup> day**  
23 **of APRIL, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Article XII, Section 1, Article VI, Section 1(g), and Article X, Section 7 of the Constitution of the**  
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**  
27 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**  
28 **pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




