

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Arizona Division of Emergency Management Hazard Mitigation
Plan Agreement Letter)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-248

- 1 **WHEREAS, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency directed the development**
2 **of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA2K), which required that all state, county,**
3 **local and tribal governments develop a hazard mitigation plan in order to be eligible**
4 **for federal disaster funds in the event of a declared disaster; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, through the DMA2K, tribal nations are required to submit a hazard mitigation plan**
6 **to the state in which each tribal nation is located for review and to the Federal**
7 **Emergency Management Agency for final approval, if the tribal nations wish to**
8 **receive federal disaster funds in the event of a declared emergency; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Division of Emergency Management has been awarded a planning grant**
10 **to provide assistance to tribal nations in the development of their respective Hazard**
11 **Mitigation Plan and has provided the match requirement of twenty five percent**
12 **(25%) to administer this grant without any obligation to tribal nations; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been approached by the Arizona Division of**
14 **Emergency Management to be an end-user recipient of the above-mentioned**
15 **planning grant, which would provide contracted assistance in the development of**
16 **the Nation's Hazard Mitigation Plan, with no cost or financial obligation to the**
17 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
- 18 **WHEREAS, the acceptance of this planning assistance requires the Nation to sign a Hazard**
19 **Mitigation Plan Agreement Letter, attached hereto; and**
- 20 **WHEREAS, a delay in receiving the correct and appropriate information from the Arizona**
21 **Division of Emergency Management caused the deadline of the acceptance of the**
22 **Hazard Mitigation Plan Agreement Letter to pass; and**
- 23 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Division of Emergency Management has submitted documentation that**
24 **extends the deadline of the acceptance of the Hazard Mitigation Plan Agreement**
25 **Letter to April 28, 2006; and**
- 26 **WHEREAS, the Office of Grants & Contracts, the Executive Office, and the Domestic Affairs**
27 **Committee have reviewed the said Agreement Letter and recommend it for signature**
28 **and, therefore, execution of the agreement which will provide for the assistance in**
29 **developing the Nation's Hazard Mitigation Plan.**

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
(Approving the Arizona Division of Emergency Management Hazard Mitigation Plan Agreement Letter)

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1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
2 Hazard Mitigation Plan Agreement Letter, attached hereto, with the Arizona Division
3 of Emergency Management as well as the deadline extension of April 28, 2006 and
4 authorizes the Vice-Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign the Agreement on
5 behalf of the Nation.

6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 7TH day
7 of APRIL, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,273.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
8 -0- NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
9 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
10 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
11 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
12 Stat. 984).

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
