## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving Distribution of the Remainder of the Gaming Compact Section 12(d), 12% for fiscal year 2005 to the Arizona Commerce and Economic Development **Commission, Local Communities Fund)** 

RESOLUTION NO. 06-294

1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 02-562, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") approved a new
2		tribal-state gaming compact (the "Compact") with the State of Arizona; and
3	WHEREAS,	as part of Section 12 of the Compact, the Nation did agree to make certain tribal
4		contributions in consideration for substantial exclusivity covenants by the State; and
5	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Section 12(d) of the Compact, the Nation agreed to contribute twelve
6		percent of the tribal contribution (the "12% Distribution") to cities, towns, and
7		counties, for government services that benefit the general public; and
8	WHEREAS,	on October 25, 2005, the Legislative Council did approve various grant agreements to
9		makepartofthe12%distribution, throughResolutionNo.05-647, anddidtransferthe
10		remaining portion of the estimated fiscal year 2005 distribution to the State of
11		Arizona's Commerce and Economic Development Commission (CEDC) through
12		Resolution No. 05-648; and
13	WHEREAS,	at the close of fiscal year 2005, the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise did undergo
14		an audit to verify accuracy of the Nation's 12% contribution estimates, among other
15		things, which  revealed  that  the  Nation  owed  an  additional  \$77,174.01  towards  the  12%
16		Distribution for fiscal year 2005.
17	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby directs
18		the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise to make payment of the \$77,174.01 owed for
19		the 12% Distribution, discovered by the Enterprise's fiscal year 2005 audit, to the
20		Arizona CEDC, Local Communities Fund established by A.R.S. §41-1505.12, as provided
21		in Compact Section 12(d)(ii).
