

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the name change of Westside Health Clinic to San Simon Health Center)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-303

1 **WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 99-444 appropriated funds for the**
2 **Design and Construction of a clinic for the Western portion of the Tohono O'odham**
3 **Nation (Nation); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Health & Human Services Department along with the Western Coalition**
5 **held Public Hearings to obtain comments and suggestions on constructing a health**
6 **facility for the Nation's western portion of the reservation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, these public hearings Nation's members residing on the western portion of the Nation**
8 **expressed enthusiastic support for a health facility in their region; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District voiced concerns about the name "Westside Health Clinic" in that**
10 **it did represent the area specifically where the facility is being constructed; and**

11 **WHEREAS, on May 13, 2004, the San Simon community held a meeting to discuss the name**
12 **change of "Westside Health Clinic" also in attendance were the Nation's Chairwoman**
13 **Vivian Juan Saunders and Gu Vo District Chairwoman Fern Salcido and it was voted**
14 **in favor by the San Simon community to change the name to San Simon Clinic & Health**
15 **Center; and**

16 **WHEREAS, on June 7, 2005 the Pisinemo District Council by Resolution No. 2005-14 approved the**
17 **name change of Westside Health Clinic to San Simon Clinic & Health Center; and**

18 **WHEREAS, on March 30, 2006, a meeting was held with the Tohono O'odham Nation and the**
19 **Tucson Area IHS Office where the name change was discussed and it was agreed that**
20 **utilizing "Health Center" in the context of the name would be most appropriate; and**


21 **WHEREAS, this issue was considered by the Pisinemo District for discussion and the Pisinemo**
22 **District Council approved District Resolution No. 2006-09 approving the name change**
23 **of the Westside Health Clinic to San Simon Health Center.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
25 **the name of the Westside Health Clinic to be officially changed and hereafter known**
26 **as the San Simon Health Center.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH day**
28 **of MAY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,360.2 FOR; 169.0 AGAINST;**
29 **718.5 NOT VOTING; and 193.1 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
31 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


