	United States Fish and Wildlife Service regarding potential impacts on endangered
	species from the project, and the Fish and Wildlife Service has issued a Biological
	Opinion which concludes that the project as proposed is not likely to jeopardize the
	continued existence of the Cactus Ferruginous Pygmy Owl or to cause an incidental
	take of this species; and
WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Indian Affairs has agreed that 135 of the 139 saguaros which will be
	removed by the project to facilitate construction will be transplanted; and
WHEREAS,	the BureauofIndianAffairsattendedcommunitymeetingsatGuAchiDistrictonAprilA
	8, 2000, at Sikul Himatk on January 18, 2005, at Gu Achi District on January 21, 2005,
	and at Sells District on February 15,2005, to review plans for the project and to receive and to review plans for the project and to receive plans p

WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the BIA's
	request for consent and recommends that the Nation provide consent, on the
	condition that the Nation retains all rights and authority over the land and activities
	conducted within the right-of-way that are not inconsistent with the rights granted to
	the United States in the right-of-way documents.
